### Christians Must Have A Consistent Message!

#### For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. Hebrews 4:12

*As You Like It* is a pastoral comedy by William Shakespeare believed to have been written in 1599. I love the title since it epitomizes how people want to live their lives and order their views. Not much has changed in the past 425 years. The truth is not the issue for most of us, too many of us want it the way we like it regardless of the facts.

The problem with Christianity in America is that nearly everyone develops their own theology based on particular passages they like. The Jesus that emerges from our "helter-skelter" approach to the Bible varies from church to church, person to person, believer to believer. No wonder the world is confused since we produce an inconsistent message using the Bible and Jesus as our backdrop.

This is what we look like to the world:

One Christian has a Jesus who accepts the gay lifestyle while another calls it an abomination.

One Christian supports abortion on demand as a women's right while another sees it as the killing of unborn children.

One Christian believes peace and justice infused with love and acceptance of all people as Jesus' message while another sees the call to repentance and submission to Jesus as biblical.

One Christian promotes wealth and riches for those who believe while another sees sacrifice and poverty as the truth.

Both cannot be true at the same time! How do we solve this problem? The answer is simple: *We must make and execute three commitments*.

**Commitment** #1: I will seek the mind of Jesus and submit to what he says in His Word regardless of what the culture is saying.

**Commitment** #2: I will study God's Word systematically and seek to hear Jesus' message in its context.

**Commitment** #3: I will apply God's Word to life with ALL that Jesus has said and done not just selective portions I like.

The Word of God has power. Properly used it can change hearts, minds and purpose for living. Those who claim to be Christians are the vehicles by which God's Word is transmitted to this world. Our goal is to be honest, consistent, and respectful of His Word so that it can change hearts and minds.
